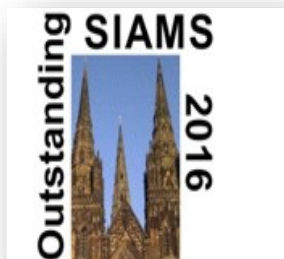




# St Paul's News
