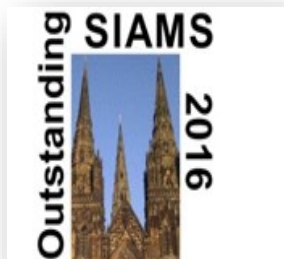




# St Paul's News

## Attendance

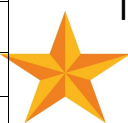
Nursery	96%
