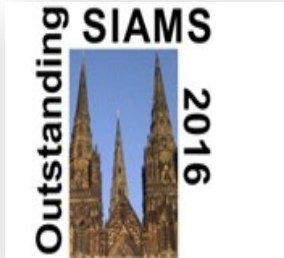

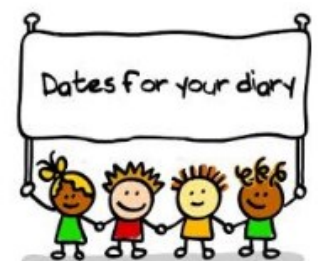
World Book Day

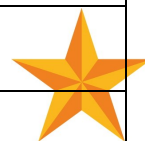
