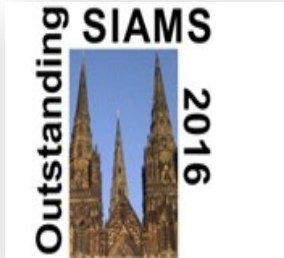

Our Family Learning First Aid Course is now running in school on a Tuesday morning. Thank you to Miss Winchurch for organising this.



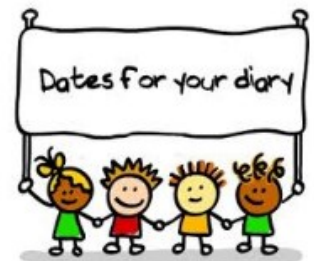
World Book Day

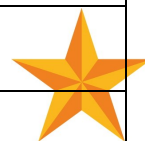
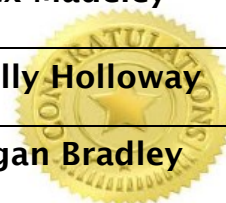
