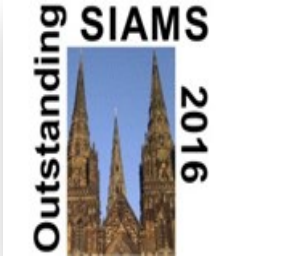

## Cold Weather

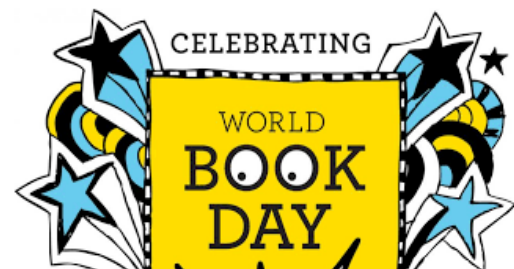
