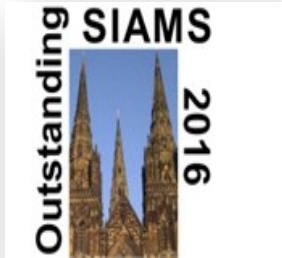

- Information is provided to parents enabling them to support their children to learn both at home and school.

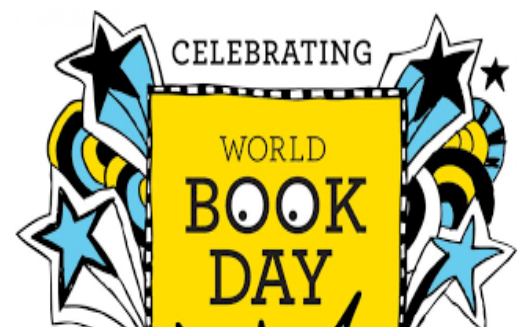

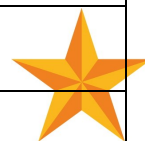
