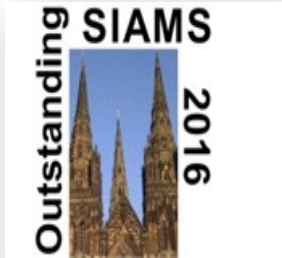

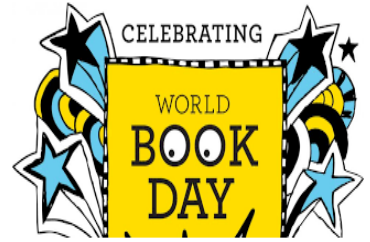
Eco-Schools Silver Award

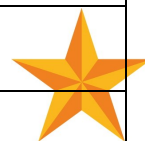
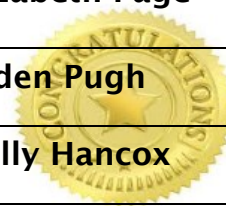
