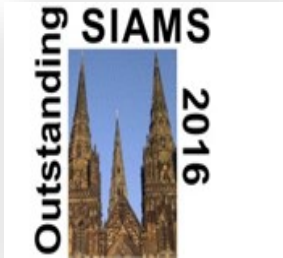




St Paul's News
