We will be celebrating Roald Dahl day in school on Thursday. All of the children will be taking part in a range of activities to celebrate the great work of this fantastic author.

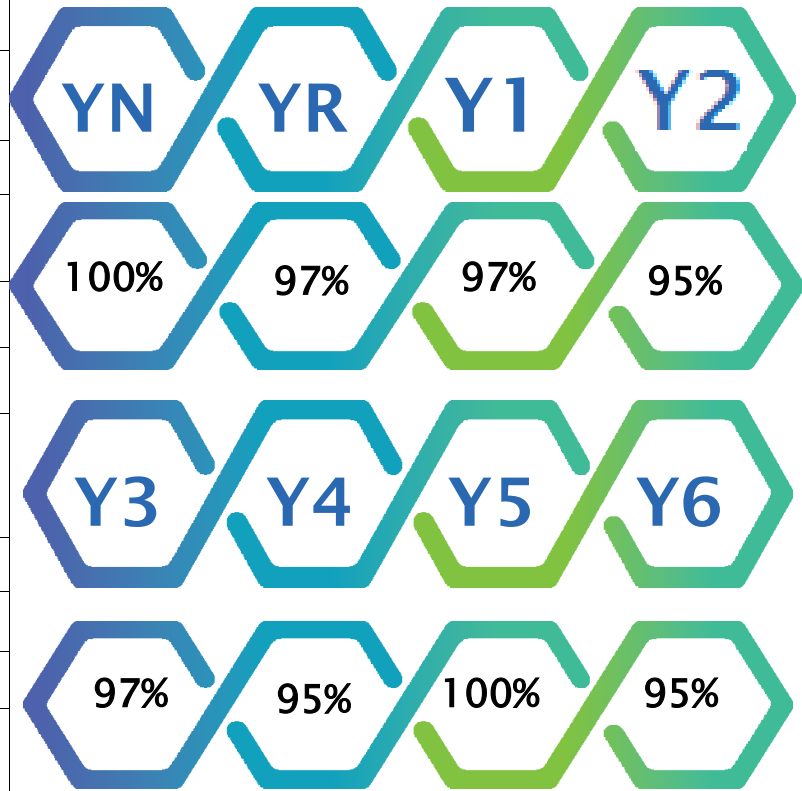
