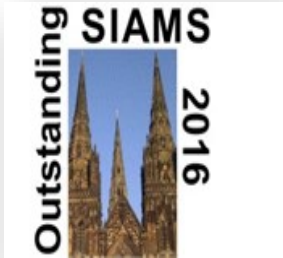


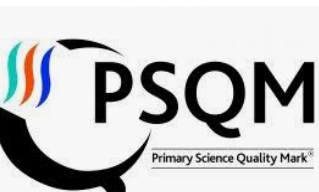

The focus for fundraising this academic year will be towards outdoor play equipment and improving our playground area. Our first event will be the disco next week, tickets are on sale at the school office.

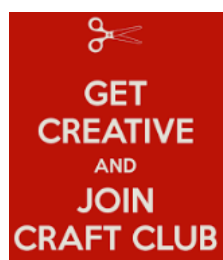


## Cross Country
