



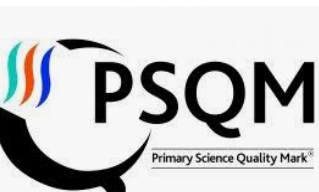

Thank you to the parents and staff who helped at the school disco this week. The A.G.M will be held after half term and there are plenty of fun events to look forward to in the run up to Christmas.

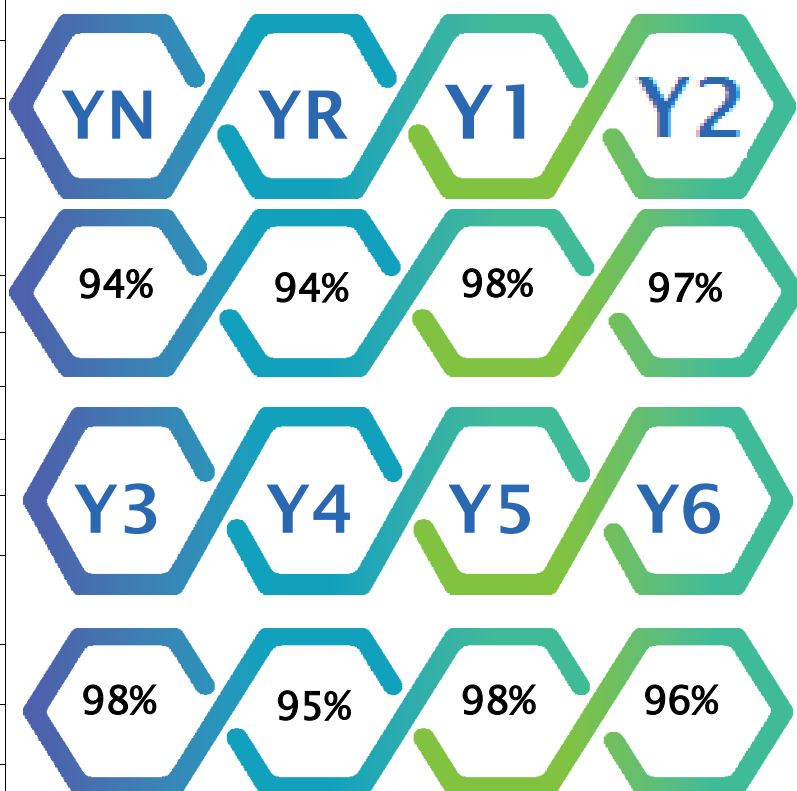
