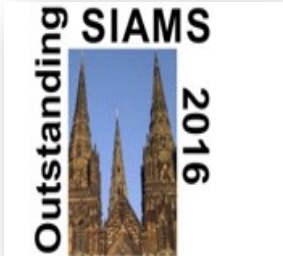

Girls Football Team

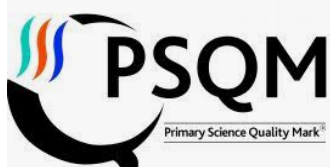

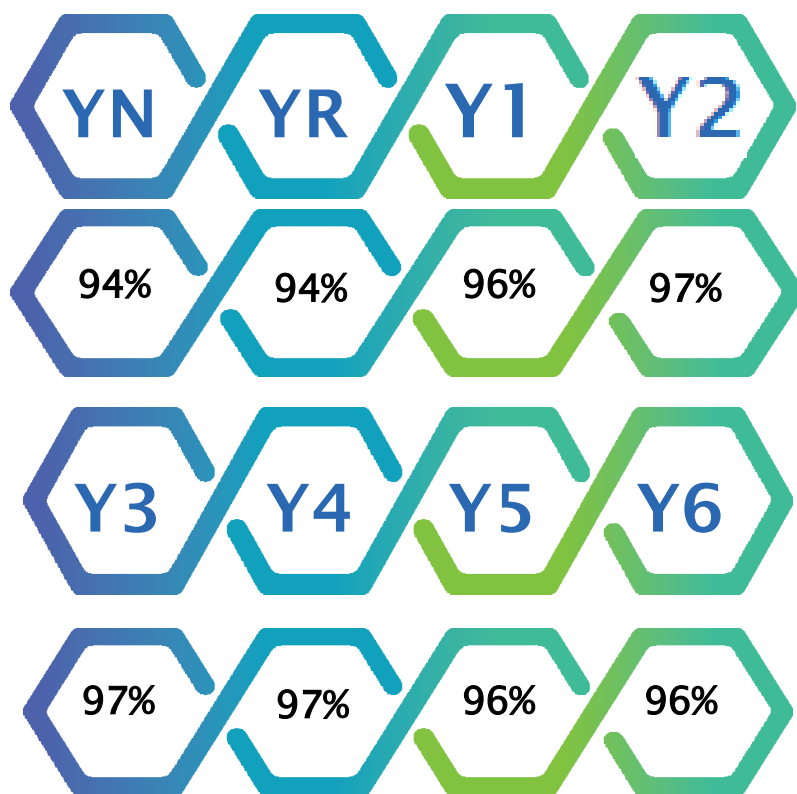
