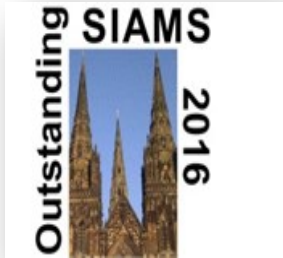

Thank you for your continued and valued support during this academic year. We have had a very busy year with many successes; these include

- KS2 SAT's results all being above national levels:
- 87% of Year 6 pupils at the expected level in Maths
- 83% of Year 6 pupils at the expected level in Writing
- 87% of Year 6 pupils at the expected level in Grammar, Spelling and Punctuation
- 73% of Year 6 pupils at the expected level in Reading
- Raising over £2500 through the Parent's Association and funding the installation of the Daily Mile and lunchtime playground equipment.
- Achieving the Sportsmark Gold for the fourth consecutive year.
- An increase of over 1% in attendance to 96.92%

We are welcoming Miss Compton to our staff team in September; she will be teaching Year 4. I am sure that you will join me in welcoming her to our school community.

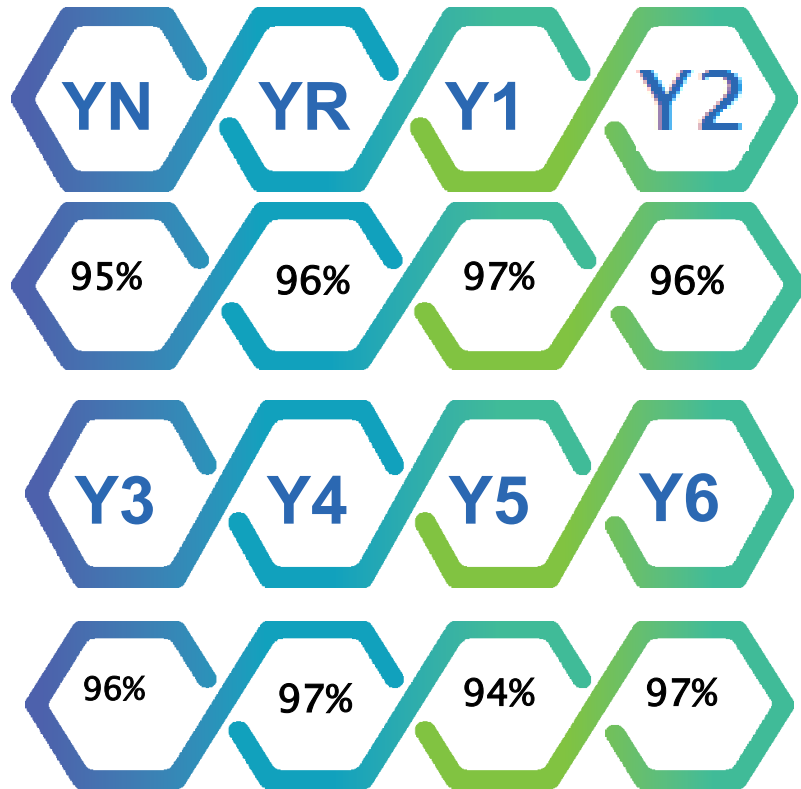
