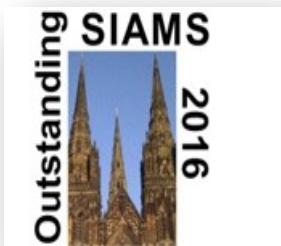

Attendance



The attendance above is the attendance for each year group for the previous academic year.

We reward all children with 100% attendance during the term with an activity afternoon, this is chosen by the School Council. There is also a class reward prize for the class with the highest attendance throughout the term.

Friday Worship

As a reminder the children can bring in certificates for achievements that they may have made out of school This could be a swimming certificate or a football trophy for example.

The children are presented with a merit certificate if they have ten merit marks in class. They can achieve a merit mark for good work or good behaviour.

A child from each class will also be nominated for a Principal’s award and they receive a small prize for this.
