After School Clubs

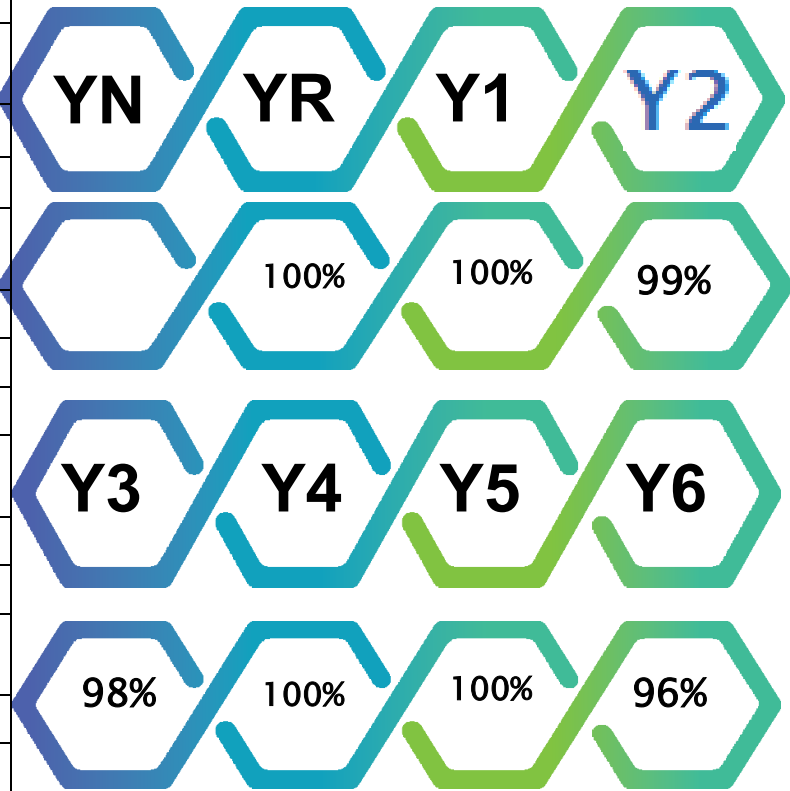
