Welcome back! We would like to say a big thank you for all of the Christmas cards and presents we received. Hopefully you had a restful break. We are looking forward to working with your child again this term.

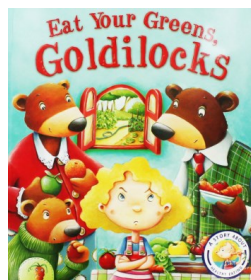
Religious Education

In R.E. this term we will be talking about our friendships and Jesus' friendships with his Disciples. We will also think about belonging.



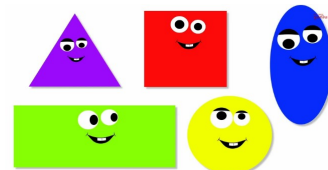
Literacy

Mathematics
