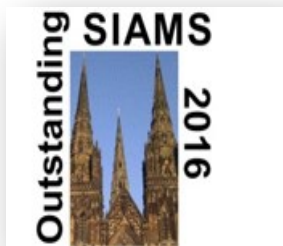

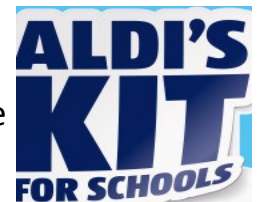
World's Biggest Coffee Morning and Non – Uniform Day

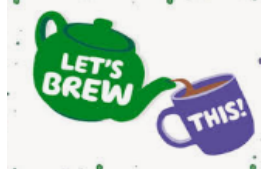
Football Team

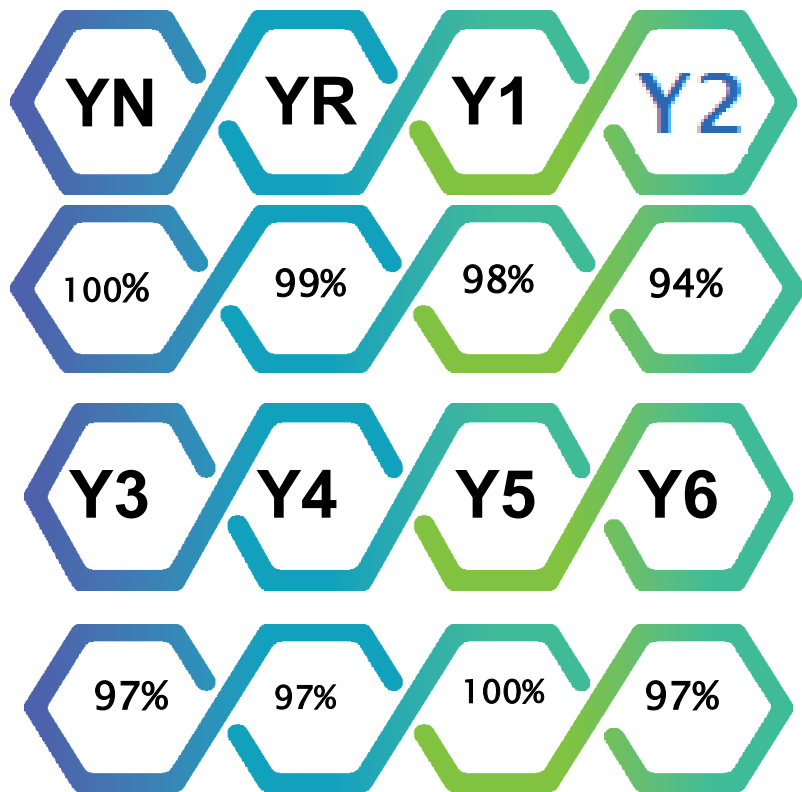
