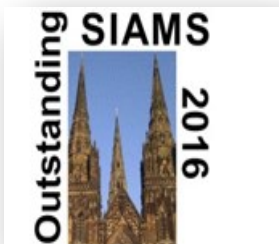

Aldi Kit for Schools

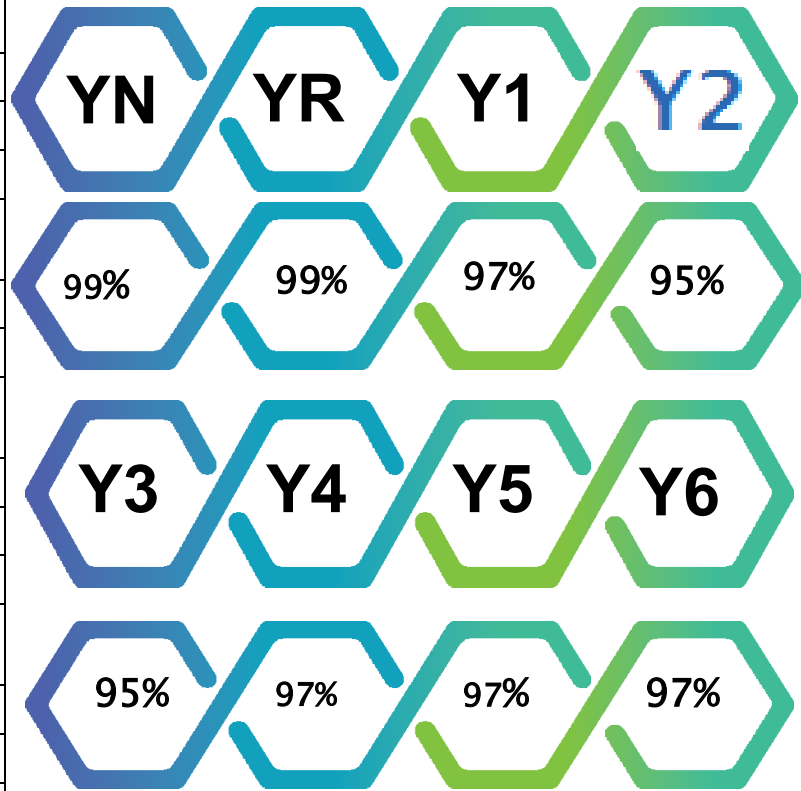
