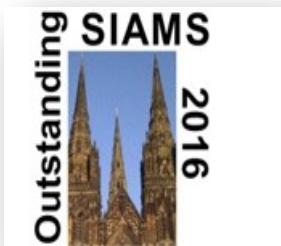

#HelloYellow

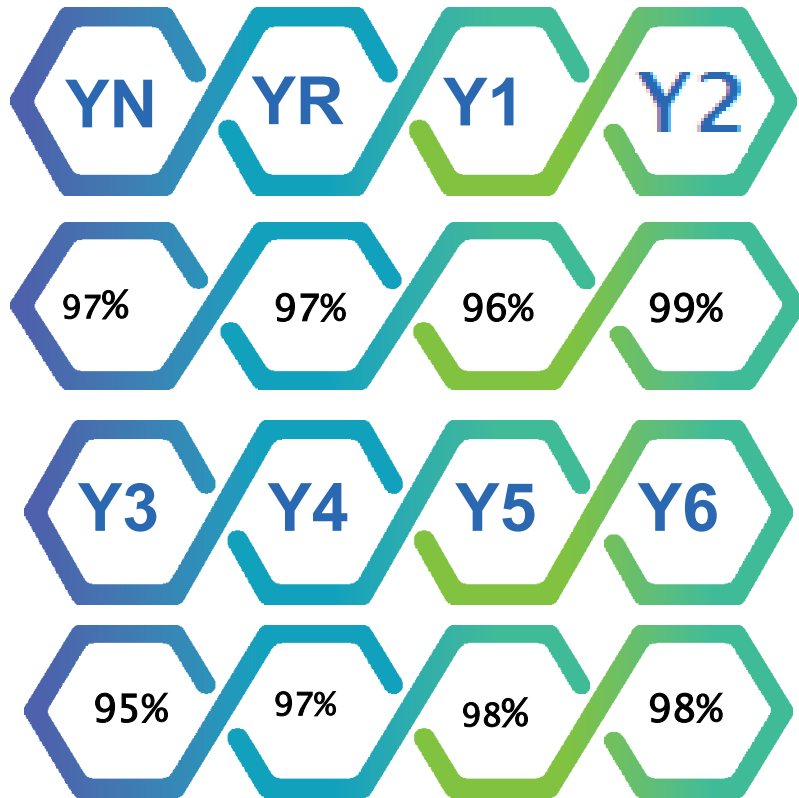
This week we have celebrated #HelloYellow day where all classes have completed work around the Healthy Mind Happy Me curriculum.
