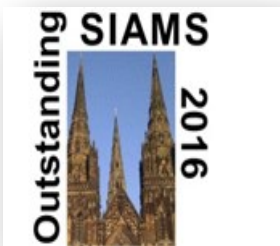




# St Paul's News

### Remembrance 2019

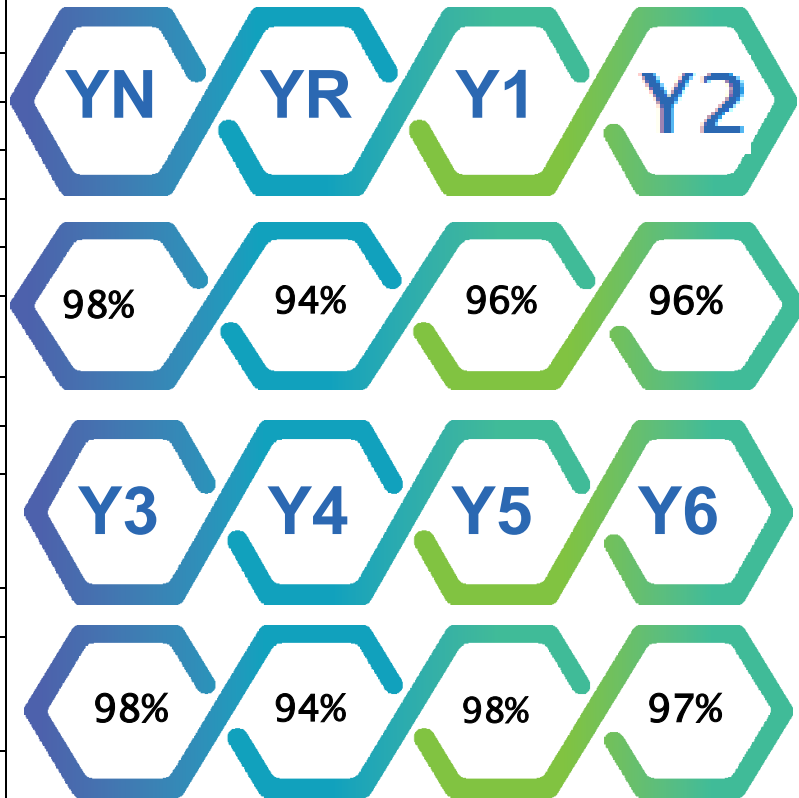
There are poppies on sale every morning before school and KS2 will be leading the Remembrance Service this Friday; 8th November in school.
