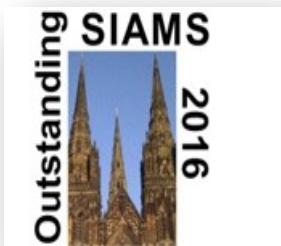

Please note that school will be closed on Thursday 12th December due to the General Election.

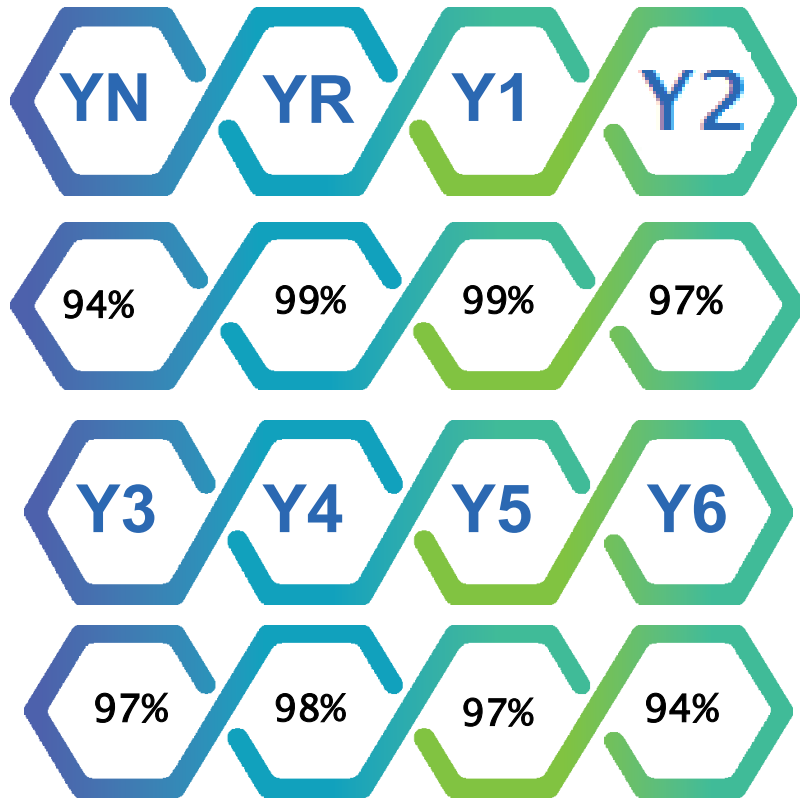
