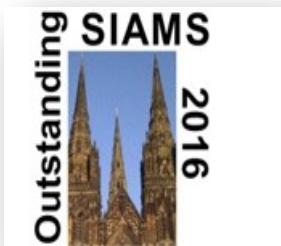

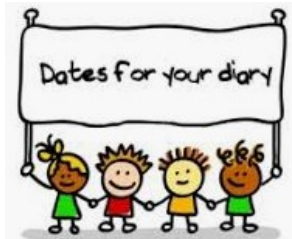
## Dear Parents and Carers,

## Cold Weather

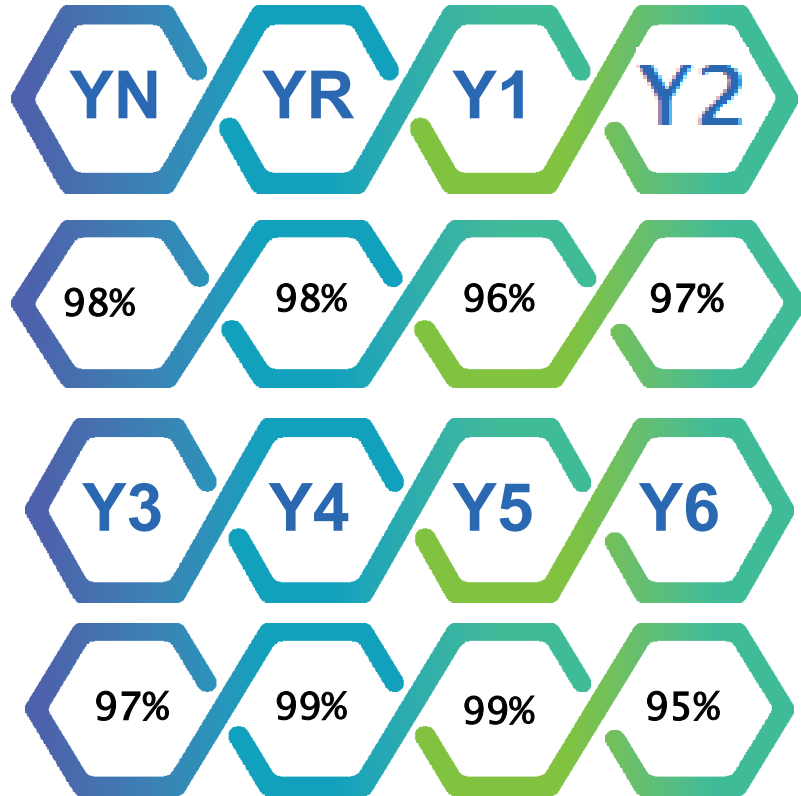
As the weather is getting much colder please ensure that your child has a warm winter coat in school, also please clearly label all hats, scarves and gloves.
