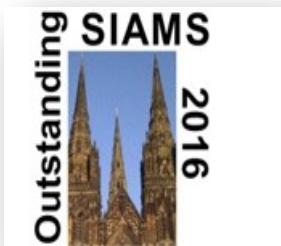




St Paul's News

Let's Play

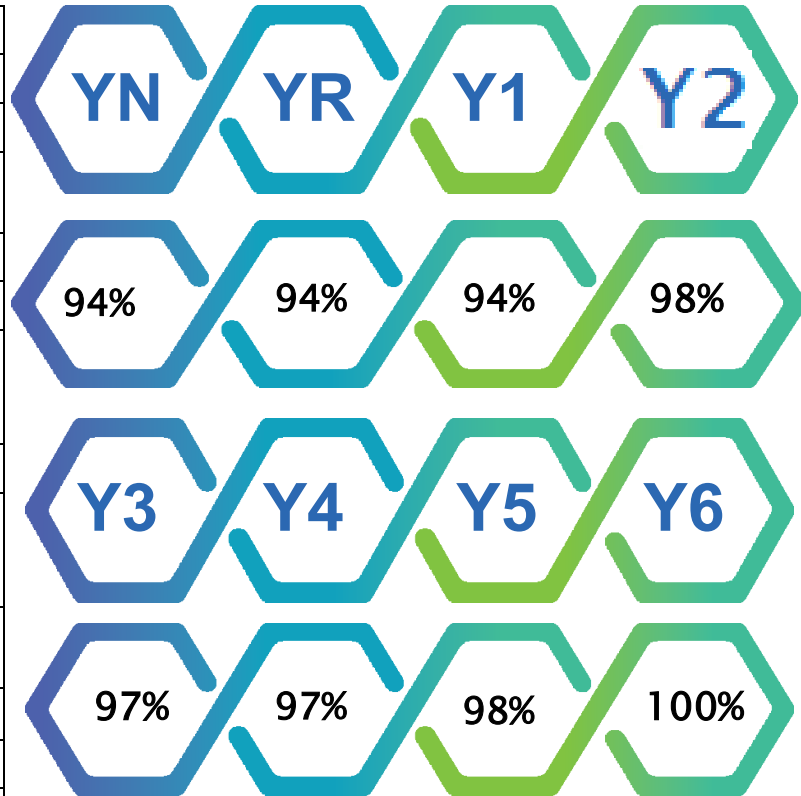
