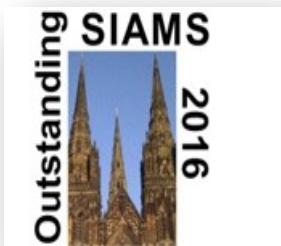

Let's Play will be running sessions on a Friday afternoon between 1.00pm and 4.00pm at Tipton Library, these sessions are free of charge.

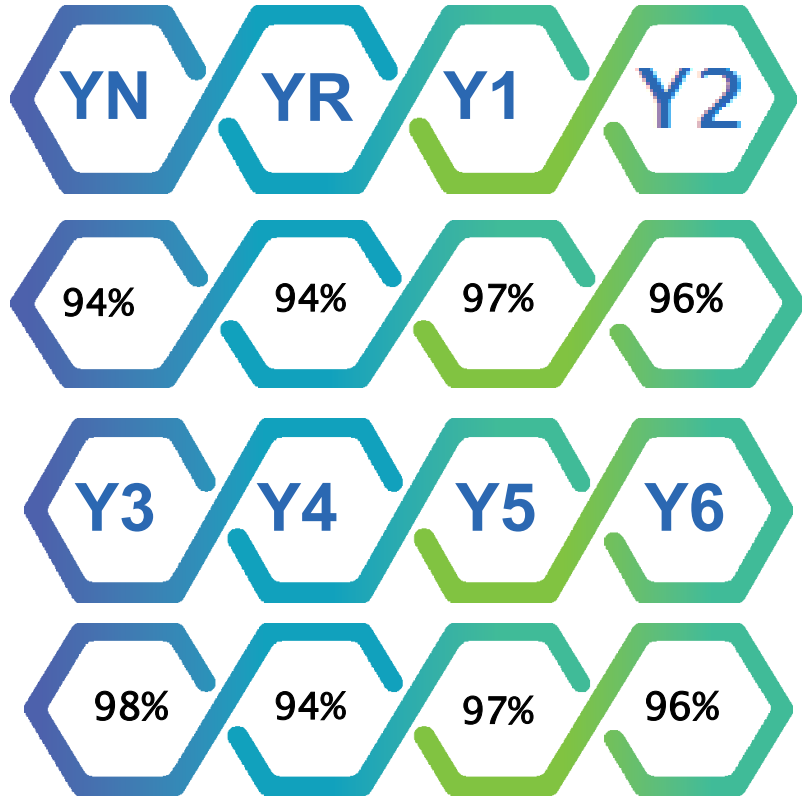
Christmas Jumper Day 13th December
