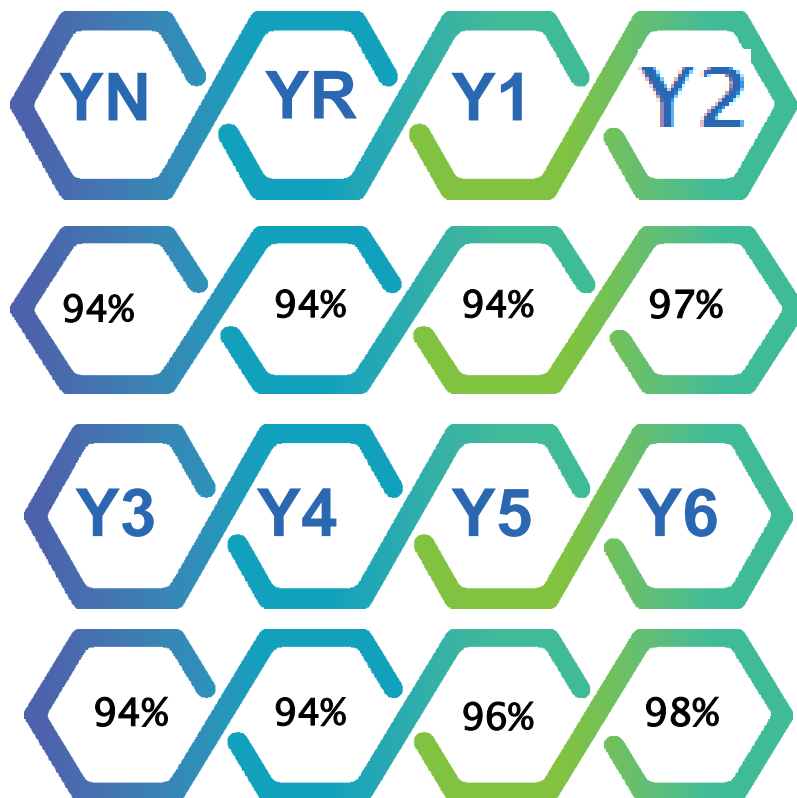
## Music Performance
