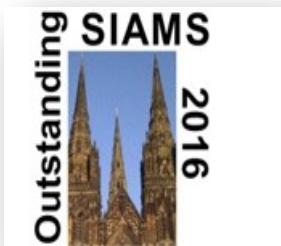

Reception Admissions 2020

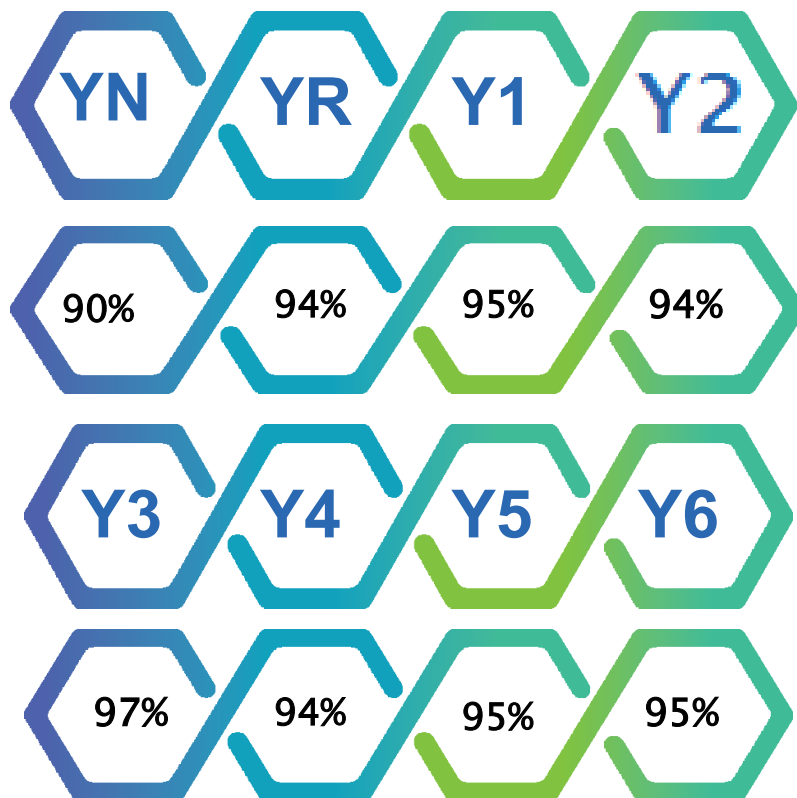
If you are applying for a Reception place for September 2020, the form needs to be filled in by midnight on the 15th January.
