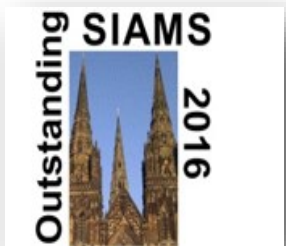

As a reminder we are closed on Thursday 6th May due to local council elections.

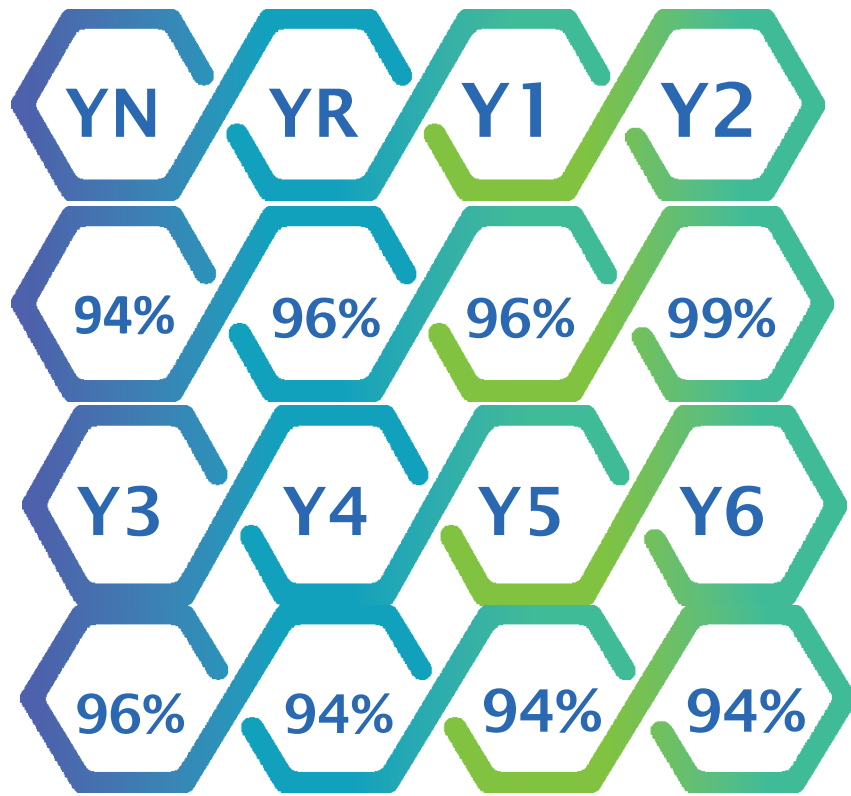
