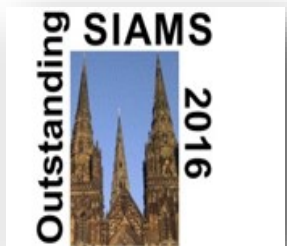

As a gentle reminder, please ensure that your child is in appropriate sportswear for P.E. lessons.

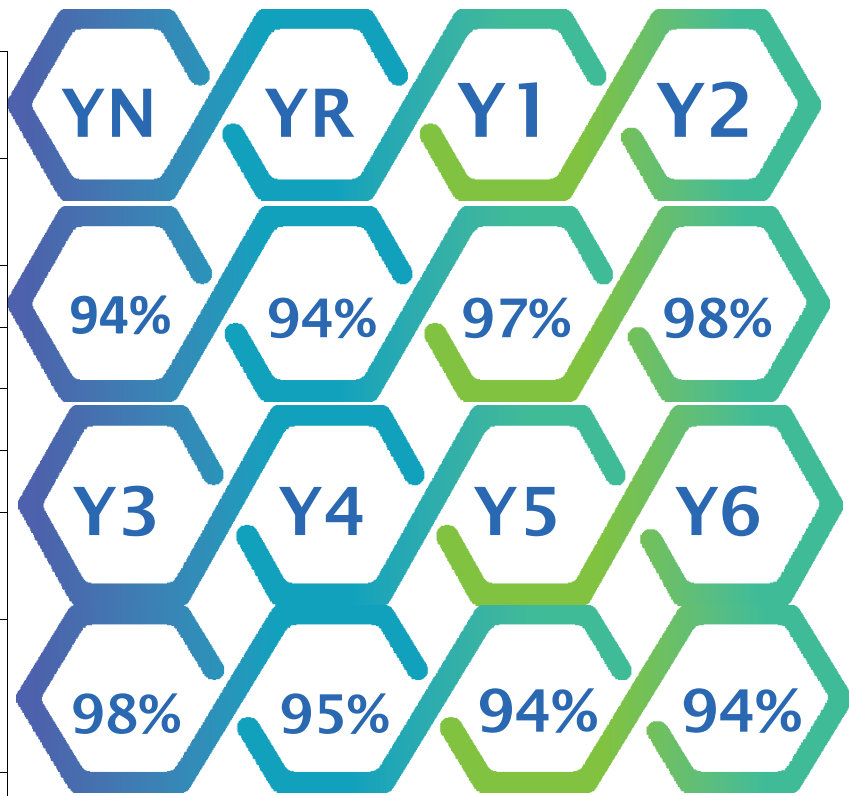
