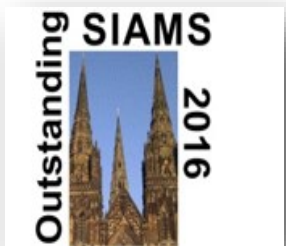

Year Two Parents

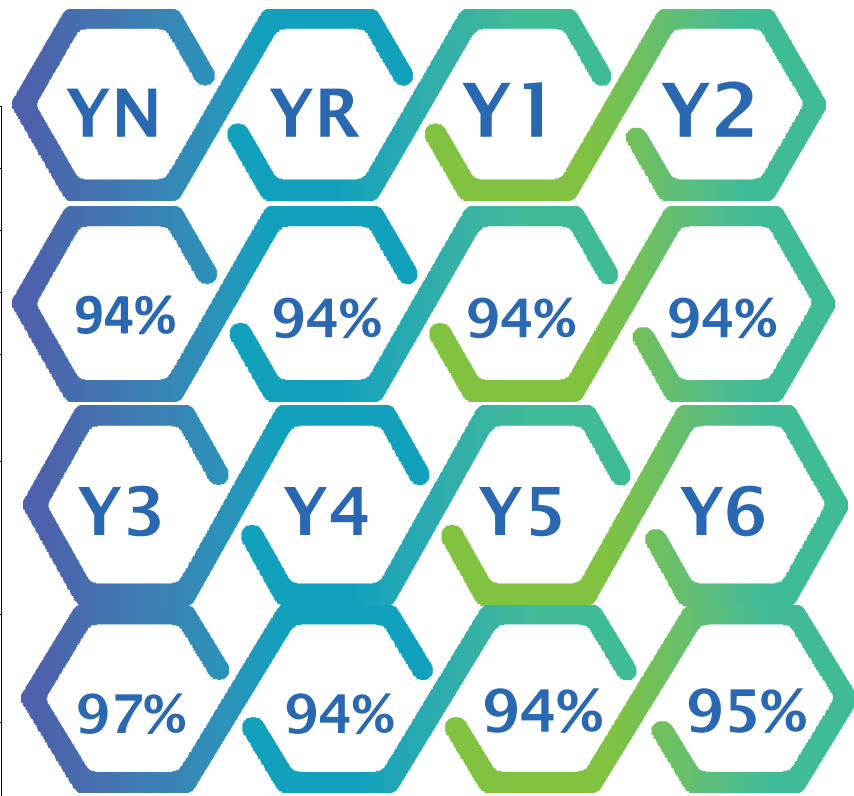
