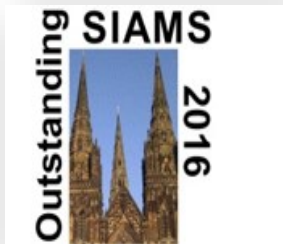

Summer Works

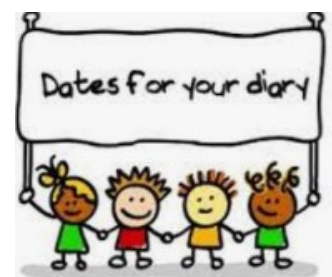

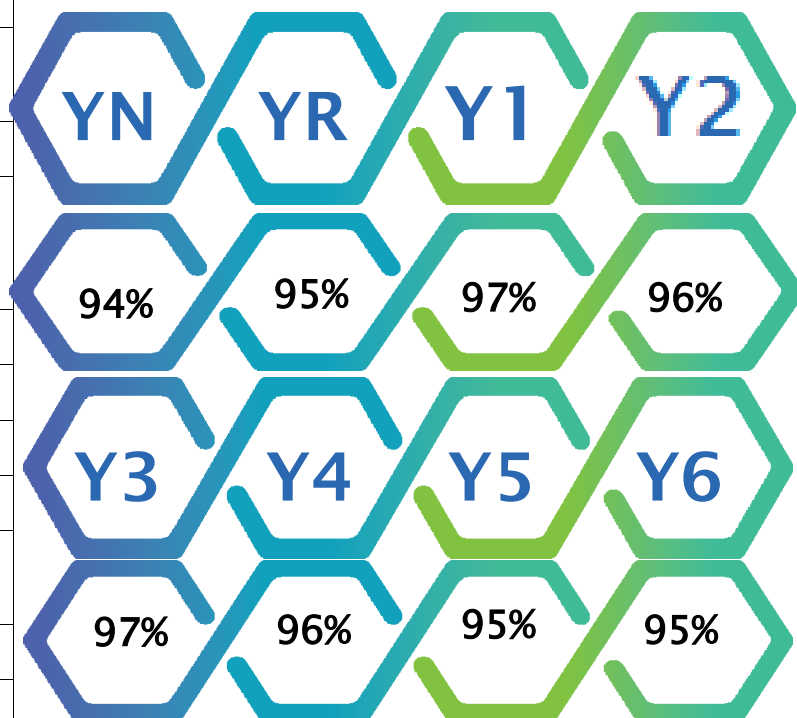
