Well done to our girls football team, winning 2-1 against Yew Tree Primary School, our first away match of the academic year. The team should be commended for their excellent sporting attitude.

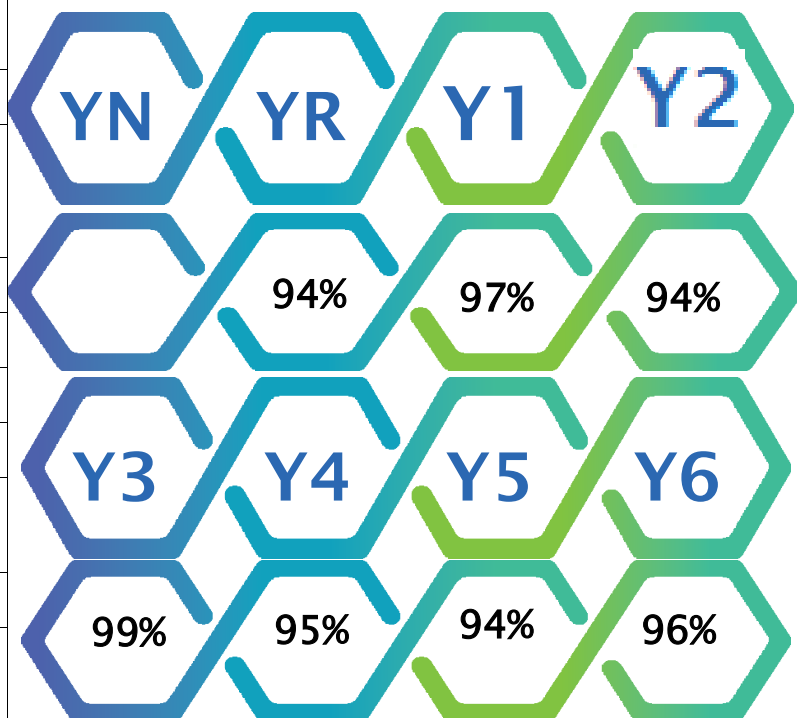
Thank you to our parents for supporting the team travel arrangements and to Mr. Westwood for organising.
