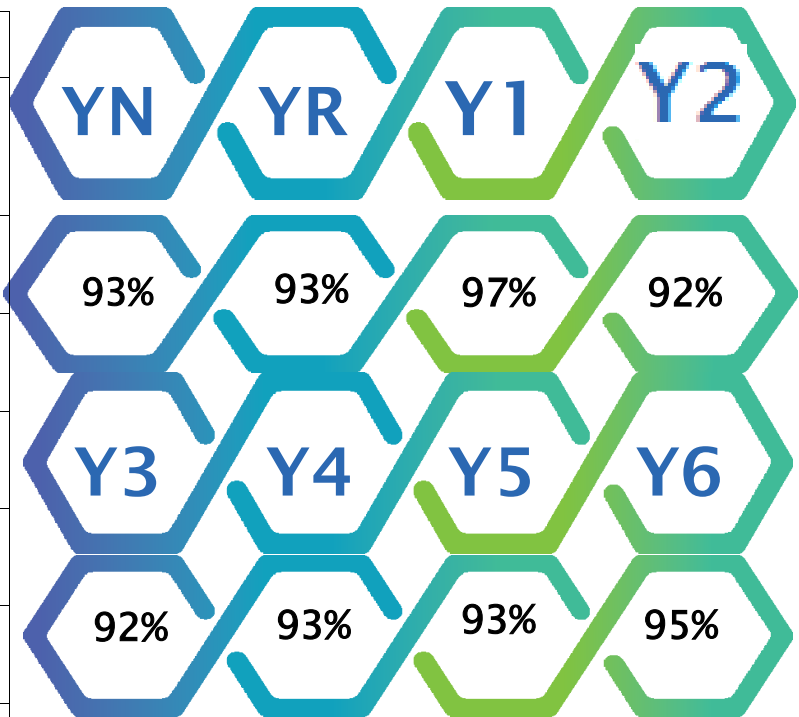
## Sports Coach
