Can you write this number? 	<p>Create – Fruity prints!</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Halve some different fruits and vegetables, then press them into a thin layer of paint. - Can you press the fruit and vegetables down to make a simple print? - Talk to a grown up about the different textures and shapes of the fruit and vegetables. 	<p>Explore – Observing and sorting seeds</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Ask a grown up if you can explore your house looking for seeds. - What different seeds can you find in fruit and vegetables? - Look closely at the seeds, how are they the same or different? (EG; size or colour) - When the seeds are dry you can stick them in your home learning books and label them.
