Investigate to see if this is true.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Put black and white paper or fabric on the floor outside. - Put a range of brightly coloured paper or fabric on the floor outside. - Observe the pieces of paper at different times of the day. What happens? 	<p>Design – What would a zebra look like if it didn’t have stripes?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Can you design a new patterned coat for a Zebra? - Think about what pattern you will design and which materials and colours you would like to use. - Use the colour and materials you have chosen to make or draw you new zebra! 	<p>Record – A baby elephant is called a calf. What are other baby animals called?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Find images online of adult and baby African animals and see if you can match them correctly. - Can you find out the name of each baby animal? - Label the baby animals. - How are the baby and adult animals the same or different?
