Focus – Heroes and Villains			
<p>Research – Fact file</p> <p>Create a fact file about a real-life hero (past or present) that you find interesting. This could be a sporting hero who inspires you or another person who you find particularly motivational. For example, Miss Lockett would choose the cyclist, Mark Cavendish. Tell me about them: who they are, where they come from, how they inspire you and draw a picture of them.</p>	<p>Research – Top 10 Villains</p> <p>Discuss what you think being a ‘villain’ means and make a list of their top 10 fictional villains. How about Darth Vader, Scar from <i>The Lion King</i> or Lord Voldemort from the <i>Harry Potter</i> novels?</p> <p>Find out more about a chosen villain, reflecting on how their actions affect others. Debate which character is the most villainous, presenting their views and opinions. After the debate, order each villain on a ‘vile villains’ scale of 1–10.</p>	<p>Create – Collage</p> <p>Choose a villain from your Top 10 Villains activity. Create a collage portrait of your character using things you find around the house. You could use paint, pencil, newspaper, coloured paper etc. You could even use things from outside in your garden like leaves and stones and build your portrait that way!</p>
