Focus – Heroes and Villains

Research – Traditional fairy tale

Choose a favourite traditional tale and make a story map or written plan to plan an alternative version. Develop and update your ideas for characters to make them into believable, contemporary figures. Think about where you might set your fairy tale. Perhaps it could be set in a large city or a shopping centre?

Remember your characters can access modern technology too. It can add an exciting element to your story. How about Hansel and Gretel using satnav, or the prince calling Cinderella on his smartphone?

Research – How things move.

Imagine that you are a villain within a superhero film. You need to plan for your getaway in your getaway vehicle so you need to make sure it can drive on lots of different surfaces. Investigate what is the best surface for a vehicle to move quickly on and how you can adapt the wheels to move across different surfaces. Different surfaces could include: tiles, carpet, outdoor terrain or whatever you have in your house. Predict what surfaces you will travel most effectively on and then test it out. Then make adaptations to your vehicle to ensure you can escape no matter what!

Create – Illustrations

Create illustrations for your alternative version of the traditional fairy tale. You could use paint, pencil, chalk, pens or draw it on your computer/tablet! Make sure you think about what is happening at each part of your story and how you can give away extra information through your inference skills!
