Focus – Heroes and Villains		
<p>Research – Composing lyrics</p> <p>Write lyrics to the tune of a familiar nursery rhyme or song about a hero or heroine. Use fun, relevant and rhyming words to make your lyrics interesting. Keep lyrics short and punchy to make them memorable.</p> <p>Good songs to use as a starting point include <i>Twinkle, Twinkle Little Star; Heads, Shoulders, Knees and Toes; Robin Hood or Wind the Bobbin Up</i>. As an example, to the tune of <i>Heads, Shoulders, Knees, and Toes</i>, sing: 'Martin Luther had a dream, had a dream. Martin Luther had a dream, had a dream, that everyone would be treated just the same, Martin Luther was his name, was his name.'</p>	<p>Research – My hero</p> <p>Discuss heroes and heroines in your lives – a parent, friend, pet or a teacher. Explain why you think their actions or behaviour are heroic. Draw a picture of your hero or heroine and write a short paragraph to explain your choice.</p> <p>You could choose a family member from the past. If you do, what do you remember about them? Why were they so special?</p>	<p>Create – Comic book strip</p> <p>Using the work you did about your hero, produce a comic strip about their lives. Think about your story ideas. They could be as simple as mum getting everyone ready in time for school every morning or Dad rescuing the cat off the garage roof.</p> <p>Draw pictures that tell your everyday hero story. Add dialogue to your comic strip with thought and speech bubbles. Make sure that your speech bubbles appear in the correct order, so that readers can follow what the characters say to each other.</p>
