## Focus – 1066

### Science

This week's science activity is investigating which of the following dissolve:

- Coffee
- Chalk
- Sugar
- Salt
- Oil
- Gravy
- Dried Herbs.

Fill glasses with the same amount of water and stir in one teaspoon of a substance, checking with an adult first. You could try coffee, sugar, salt, flour, oil, chalk, gravy powder and dried herbs. Predict if the substance will dissolve, then find out. Try the experiment again with warm water. Does this make a difference to your results? How did you make this a fair test?

### Research – 1066

The year is 1066, Edward the Confessor is dying and he's asked Harold Godwinson to take over the throne. But Harold's claim is under threat from three powerful men: William, Duke of Normandy; Harald Hardrada, the King of Norway; and Edgar the Atheling, Edward's nephew.

Create a fact file about one of the potential kings. Summarise your fact files with a clear opinion on the strength of their individual's claims. Remember to write in the past tense.

### Create – 1066

Create a picture timeline that sequences the events of the year 1066. Use information texts, documentaries, online resources and images, cross-referencing different source materials to check the accuracy of the source.

Use the timeline to explain the struggles for power in England at this time.

**Note:** Include such events as King Edward's death, his funeral at Westminster Abbey, the coronation of Harold Godwinson, Harald Hardrada's invasion, the battle at Fulford Gate, Harold's victory at Stamford Bridge, William's invasion in the South, the Battle of Hastings and William being crowned king at Westminster Abbey.
