### Research – 1066

Then write a diary entry, as if you are King Harold in the days leading up to the Battle of Hastings.

How are you feeling?

Remember to include the key features of a diary entry

### Create – 1066

Look at images or reconstructions of helmet designs from the Norman era, finding out what materials they were made from and why. Notice how the separate sections of a helmet are fitted together.

Follow instructions or create a design to make a Norman helmet with a nose guard. Explain why it is important to cut the sections neatly and demonstrate how the parts could be securely fixed together.

Evaluate the effectiveness of joins and the neatness of their cutting on the finished helmets.
