Date Set –11th May

Focus – Time Traveller

Create – some questions that you would like to ask someone from a different period in history. Which period in history would you choose and why? Would the person be a famous historical figure? What answers do you think they might give? Write out your questions and then get a family member to ask you the questions as if you were from another period in history.

Research – Think of an object that we use now and imagine if you took it back in time to 300-400 years in the past. For example, taking a mobile phone back to 1620. You need to explain how it works and why we use it. Would people in 1620 be intrigued or would they be suspicious and think it was something to do with witchcraft? Therefore, you need to make your explanation clear and convincing so that people aren't fearful! Consider the advantages and disadvantages of the object that you have taken back in time – could we live without it?

Research – Show me what you understand about air resistance. To do this you can have a go at making some paper aeroplanes. Try out a range of different designs to see which fly best. Predict which one you think will fly best and why. You can then fly your paper aeroplanes and measure how far they fly and record the measurements in a table or graph. Once you have compiled all of your evidence, make a conclusion about which was best and why, as well as writing an explanation about air resistance.
