Create – some fun facts about time, like:

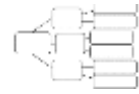
Did you know?

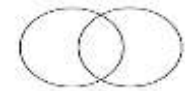
See what other amazing facts you can find out about humans and time.

Research – what do you know about gestation? ‘Gestation’ means how long it takes for a baby mammal to grow inside its mother before they are born. See which animals take the shortest and longest times, including humans. You could show this information on a scale from shortest to longest, as well as including some illustrations and annotations to accompany your findings. Did you know that ‘gestation’ come from the Latin ‘gestare’, which means ‘to carry’?

Research- everyday materials (you could think about items that you have in the home) like paper, wood, metal. Compare and group them together on the basis of their properties, including their hardness, solubility, transparency, conductivity (electrical and heat), and their response to magnets. Record your findings either as a flow chart
