Focus – Time Traveller

Create – Have a look online at hieroglyphics to help you understand what they are and how they were used. Once you have a better understanding, see if you can create some writing using the hieroglyphics. Perhaps you could have a go at writing your name or a secret message for someone in your family to work out.

Research – What do you know about the location of Egypt and its physical and human geographical features. Use online maps and other information sources to describe Egypt’s landscape, surrounding countries and seas, climate and significant geographical features. Locate important places such as Cairo, Giza and the Valley of the Kings, where Tutankhamun’s tomb was found. Make a sketch and or digital map of Egypt and mark its significant features. Add a key for reference purposes.
