Attendance

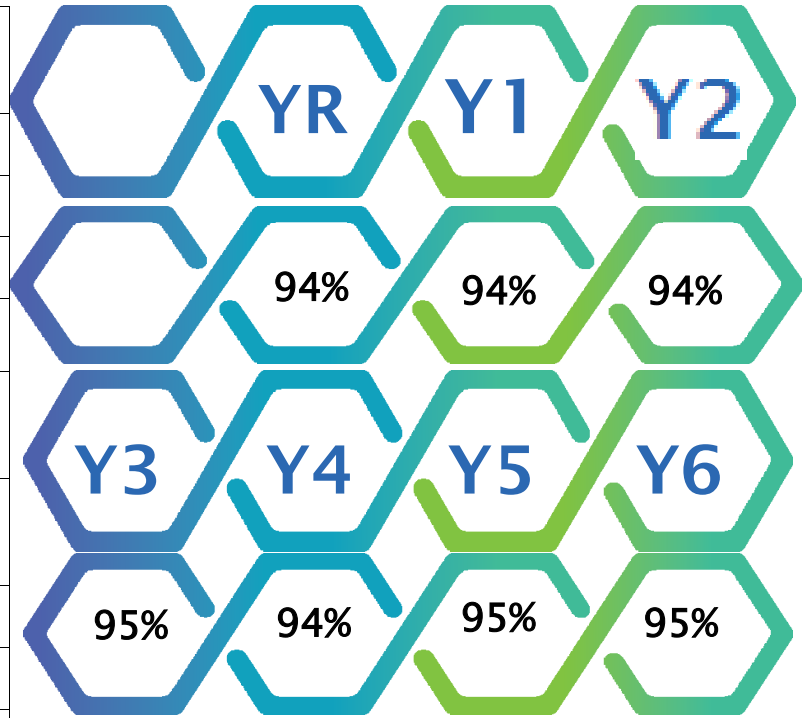
There has been an update in laws regarding school attendance and this includes an increase in fines. Please find this information attached.



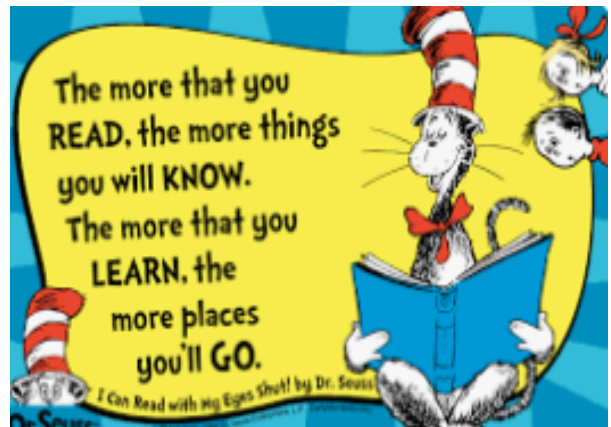
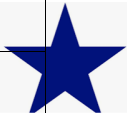
