Leading Parent Partnership Award

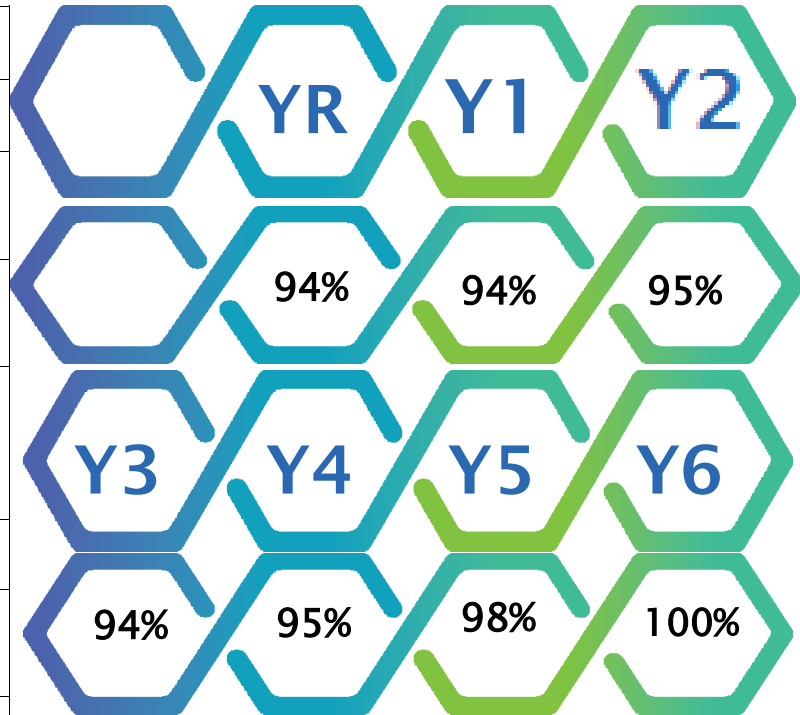

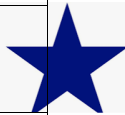

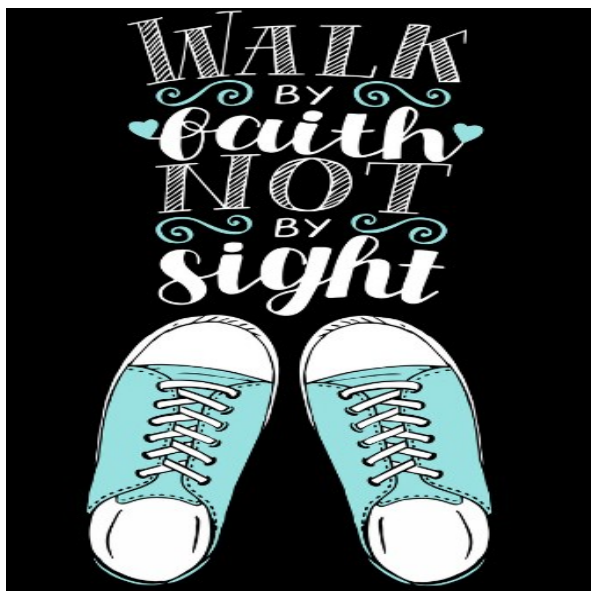
Attendance
