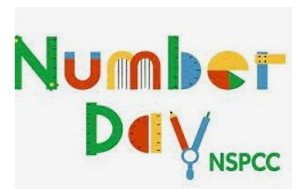


Educational Visits

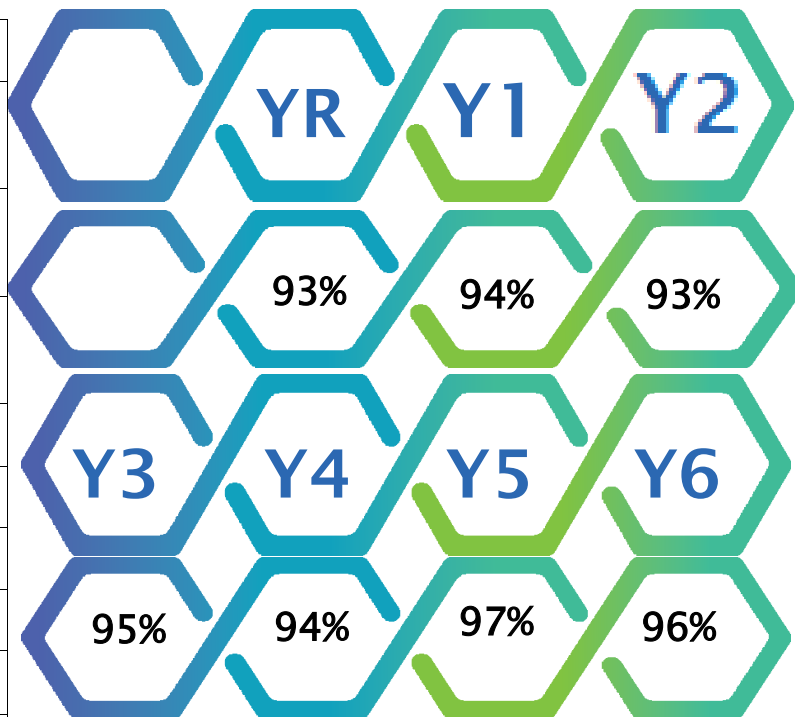
