As always school is busy with events this half term, we are looking forward to our Easter Celebration as well as our journey through Lent.

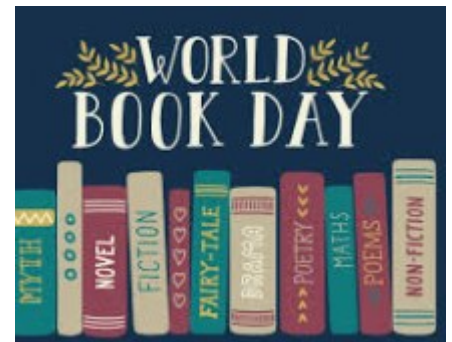

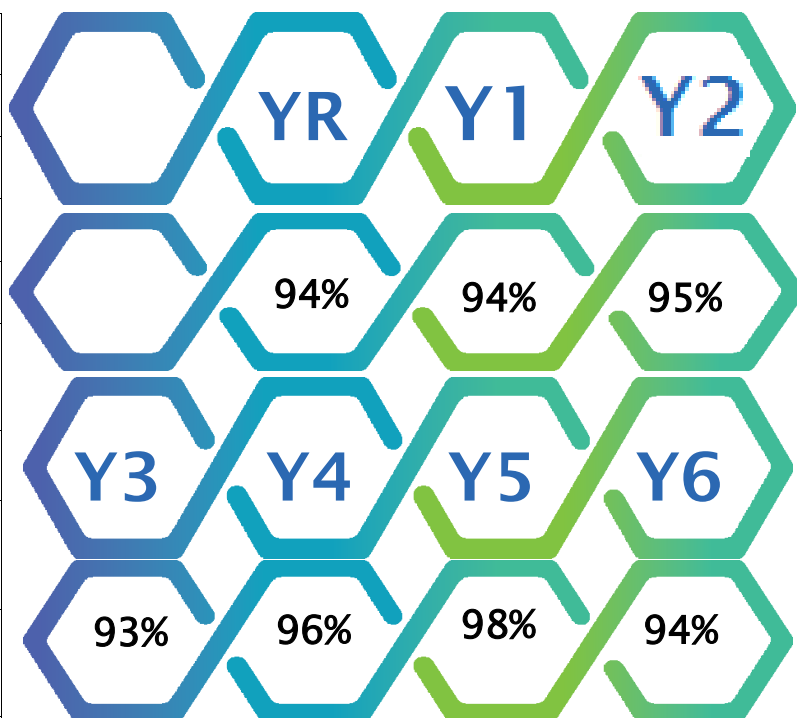
